Barbara’s husband was the Dugger descendant, and she did a ton of research trying to sort out all the Duggers in Brunswick and Surry Counties, Virginia. She consulted original records and microfilm and transcribed every record she could locate.

We first met in 1991 via correspondence. In 1997 she sent these notes to me. She told me I could use these notes in any manner I saw fit and there was no need to even acknowledge that they came from her! Such generosity is rare, but I couldn’t use her material without giving her credit. It just didn’t seem right.

I have consulted her notes many times over the years, and now that I’ve learned of her passing, I just have to post them on the Internet for others to use.

I’m sure she would be thrilled to have her material easily available to all Dugger researchers.
