It would appear that there were two Sampson Duggers, otherwise why would the identifying "Jr." or "Sr." have been used? A more careful study of the land tax books probably would clarify whether the above entries were "Jr." or "Sr.".

It has been suggested that the elder Sampson Dugger may have been husband of "." Lurany/Urana Dugger, daughter of John Dugger, Sr., who married, in 1784, as her second husband, Joseph Price.

## Dugger vs Dugger

This cause by consent of parties came on again to be heard upon the papers formerly read and upon the report of the Comr. [blot] by counsel. Upon consideration whereof the court doth order the said Comr. to collect the money for which the tract of land was sold & first pay all expenses attending suit &c, & then proceed to divide the balance into eleven parts & to pay one part thereof to the complainant.
